#### **Understanding Your Home Valuation**

**Zillow & Property Values aka** The "Zestimate", an automated algorithm that gives home owners an instant value on their property, it is not an appraisal. Depending on the recent sales activity in the immediate area and the conformity of the overall homes and topography, Zillow can be accurate to within a few hundred dollars or off by hundreds of thousands of dollars. In areas with conforming tract homes and recent sales, Zillow can be a bit more accurate. But in areas with unique factors, like views, custom homes, redeveloping neighborhoods, or a lack of recent sales, Zillow can have huge discrepancies. **Zestimates are currently within 5 percent of the final sales price 38.4 percent of the time.** If I were only within 5 percent of the actual sales price 38.4 percent of the time, I'd be out of business...now let that soak in.

Valuation is one of the most difficult skills to master as a real estate professional. Even if there's a matching home next door, each property has its own set of distinct characteristics that should be considered in the equation. I have taken extensive training on valuing properties and most recently have been certified a **PSA** (**Pricing Strategy Advisor**) by the National Association of REALTORS<sup>®</sup>. Providing my clients with a thorough CMA (Comparative Market Analysis) is critical to a successful sale. Depending on the type of property, a well-rounded market analysis and report can take an agent several hours to prepare. Agents should be using information from tax records and the MLS. Property characteristics used for value consideration are square footage, lot size, location, condition, style and a handful of other factors – the same method used by real estate appraisers to compile reports. Keep in mind that a CMA or appraisal arise from an **in-person** visit to your home, a Zestimate does not.

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Here are just a few of the factors that should go into a CMA:

- Past Sales
- Pending Sales
- Competing Properties
- Availability of Financing
- Uniqueness of the Product
- Potential Buyer Pool
- Conditions of the Sale

# **Nesting Advice**

### **Carbon Monoxide Detectors**

The winter is the peak time for carbon monoxide exposures, since the cold weather means homes are often sealed up tight. Carbon monoxide gases result from the burning of wood, natural gas, oil, and kerosene. It is odorless and colorless, which means homeowners wouldn't know its presence unless they had a detector to alert them to when levels get dangerous inside their home. Carbon monoxide can be deadly. When gas levels get high, homeowners may start to experience a headache, dizziness, nausea, weakness, vomiting, and shortness of breath. If carbon monoxide is ever suspected, homeowners should leave the home immediately and then call 911. Carbon monoxide is light so it can rise with warm air inside the home. Experts recommend placing a carbon monoxide detector or alarm on a wall about five feet above the floor or on the ceiling and on every floor of the home. Experts also recommend having a backup battery in carbon monoxide detectors, since some of the most common situations where the gas can be dangerous is during power outages. With real estate transactions it is required by law that sellers install a carbon monoxide detector within 15' of all sleeping spaces prior to closing.

#### What are the benefits of the Renovation Loan?

If you're buying a home that needs repairs, there are multiple loan options available. How a home renovation loan works will depend on the type of financing you decide to apply for. Popular home renovation loan options include the following programs:

Fannie Mae HomeStyle®: The Fannie Mae HomeStyle® loan is a single-close loan that includes the cost of home repairs in the overall loan amount. This loan can be used for repairs that an appraiser requires, or for changes the homeowner wants to make, and it can be used to pay for both structural and cosmetic repairs. In example if the sale price is \$450,000.00 and the repairs are \$30,000.00, you can receive one loan for the total of \$480,000.00 to cover the cost of all repairs and purchase price.

FHA 203(k): This government-backed loan is similar to HomeStyle<sup>®</sup>, but it's open to buyers with lower credit scores. This is usually the more expensive option of the two because FHA mortgages have higher mortgage insurance premiums for borrowers who apply with smaller down payments. These mortgages have an upfront fee that's included in the overall principal of the loan.

#### When Should You Consider a **Home Renovation Loan?**

You should only consider borrowing money to renovate your home if you're confident that the project will either reduce your long-term costs or increase the value

of your property Or the property you are Purchasing needs updating in major areas of the home. Some home renovation projects can increase your property value by a greater amount than what you spend on renovations. Attic insulation, basements, bathrooms and front door remodels top the list for valuable repairs. If you're hoping to improve
